

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO IDLY LOITER OR AIMLESSLY WANDER ABOUT THE STREETS AND PROPERTY OF THE CITY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 12:01 A.M. AND SUNRISE, DECLARING THE SAME TO BE A MISDEMEANOR AND FIXING THE PUNISHMENT THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Waverly as follows:

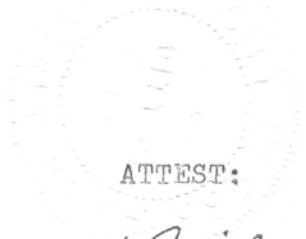
SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to idly loiter or aimlessly wander about the city streets and other public property, whether walking or riding in an automobile, between the hours of 12:01 A. M. and sunrise.

SECTION 2. Any violation of this Ordinance is declared to be a misdemeanor and the punishment therefor shall be a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or Thirty (30) days in Jail, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Board of Aldermen and Mayor.
